To extend the licensable hours for the provision of live music on Sundays from 1200 to 0030 to 1200 until 0200. To extend the licensable hours for the provision of live music on Sundays preceding a Bank Holiday Monday from 1200 to 0200 to 1000 until 0300 hours.

To extend the licensable hours for the provision of recorded music Monday to Saturday 1030 to 0200 to 1000 until 0300 and on Sundays from 1200 to 0030 to 1000 until 0200. To extend the licensable hours for

the provision of recorded music on Sundays preceding a Bank Holiday Monday from 1200 to 0030 to 1000 until 0300.
