

BRIDGEND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL (A48 PYLE)
(40MPH SPEED LIMIT) TRAFFIC ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Bridgend County Borough Council (“the Council”) have made an Order in exercise of their powers under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and in consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act the effect of which is:-

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to be driven at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour, other than an exempted vehicle, on the lengths of roads and sides of lengths of roads contained in the schedule of this Notice.

The prohibition introduced by the Order will not apply to an exempted vehicle. In the Order “exempted vehicle” means: (a) any vehicle being used by the emergency services for the purposes described in section 87 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;(b) any vehicle being used for naval, military or air force purposes, and being driven by a person for the time being subject to the orders of the member of the armed forces of the Crown, who is a member of the special forces-(i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving at high speeds: or (ii) for the purposes of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds. “special forces” means those units of the armed forces the maintenance of whose capabilities is the responsibility of the Director of Special Forces or which are for the time being subject to the operational command of that Director.

SCHEDULE (40MPH SPEED LIMIT)
A48 PYLE

- (i) From a point in line with the county borough boundary between Bridgend County Borough Council and Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council, southwards for a distance of approximately 70 meters (77 yards).

The order was made on the 29/08/2024 and will come into force on the 12/09/2024. If any person wishes to question the validity of any Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
