O ran derbyn iadau i ysgolion a gynhelir gan awdurdodau lleol, mae plant a anwyd rhwng 1 Medi 2022 a 31 Rhagfyr 2022 yn gymwys ar gyfer lle rhan amser yn dechrau ym mis Ionawr 2026 ac mae plant a anwyd rhwng 1 Ionawr 2023 a 31 Mawrth 2023 yn gymwys ar gyfer lle rhan amser gan ddechrau ym mis Ebrill 2026.

Os ydych chi'n rhiant/gofalwr i blentyn sy'n gymwys ar gyfer lle ym mis Medi 2025 mae'n **rhaid** cwblhau cais derbyn ysgol. Os bydd ysgol yn derbyn gormod o geisiadau, hynny yw, os yw'r galw am leoedd yn fwy na'r nifer o leoedd sydd ar gael, bydd y awdurdod lleol yn defnyddio ei feini prawf gormod o alw i ddyrannu'r lleoedd sydd ar gael. Mae Polisi Derbyn i Ysgolion y awdurdod lleol 2025-2026 yn nodi'r rhestr lawn o feini prawf ar gyfer gormod o alw.

Mae'n rhaid i bob rhiant/gofalwr, sy'n gwneud cais am le Meithrin i blentyn, gofnodi ar y ffurflen gais y cyfeiriad y mae ei blentyn yn preswylio ynddo fel arfer ar hyn o bryd.

Dear parent/carer

Admission to school - Nursery

Children born between 1 September 2021 and 31 August 2022 are eligible for a full-time Nursery place in a local authority maintained school within Bridgend County Borough, from September 2025.

Additionally, children are entitled to receive a free part-time Nursery place from the term following their third birthday. This place can be in a local authority maintained school or a private playgroup/nursery. In respect of admissions to local authority maintained schools, children born between 1 September 2022 and 31 December 2022 are eligible for a part-time place starting in January 2026 and children born between 1 January 2023 and 31 March 2023 are eligible for a part-time place starting in April 2026.

Parents/carers of eligible children **must** complete a school admission (Nursery) application. Even if your child is due to start attending a part-time Nursery class in either January 2026 or April 2026, there is no automatic right to a full-time Nursery place in September 2026.

You are able to apply online. If you have already signed up to 'My Account' on the Bridgend County Borough Council (BCBC) website, you will need to log in and you can then complete an online application for a Nursery school place.

If you have not already signed up to My Account, you can create your account from the Bridgend County Borough Council website. All you need is an email address.

It is quick and easy to apply for a Nursery school place through My Account and you can have peace of mind knowing that your application has been received because once you have submitted the application, this will be indicated in your My Account summary information.

The online application works equally well on PC, tablet device or mobile phone.

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The application form is also available as a hardcopy upon request, either from your local school or from the local authority on telephone number 01656 642622.

The online full-time Nursery application will be available through My Account from 10am on Monday 6 January 2025. Please note that the deadline for receipt of completed full-time Nursery applications is **4pm on Friday 4 April 2025**.

The online part-time Nursery application will be available through My Account from 10am on Monday 6 January 2025. Please note that the deadline for receipt of completed part-time Nursery applications is **4pm on Friday 29 August 2025**.

Failure to submit an application by the deadline may result in your child being refused a place at the school of your choice.

All parents/carers have the right to express a preference for the school they wish their child to attend. In most cases, parents/carers are happy to choose their nearest suitable school (for English-medium schools, this is also known as the catchment school). If you are successful in applying for a place at a school that is not your child's nearest suitable school, the local authority **will not** normally provide free transport, irrespective of the distance from your home to the school.

Parents/carers should familiarise themselves with the new [Home-to-School Transport Policy 2025](#) which is available on the local authority website. It is important to note, there be significant reductions in eligibility for many pupils as a result of this new policy, which will apply from the start of the school year in September 2025. Therefore, parents/carers should consider the eligibility of their child for school transport long term in any decision they make in considering a school for their child, at both primary and secondary school.

Where a school is oversubscribed, that is, the demand for places is greater than the number of places available, the local authority will apply its oversubscription criteria to allocate the places available. The local authority's School Admissions Policy 2025-2026 identifies the full list of oversubscription criteria. **It is strongly recommended that you select another school as your second preference school.** This can be the nearest suitable school for your child or another school. **Limiting your choice to just one school does not improve your prospects of gaining a place for your child in that school.** Please note that there is no automatic right for pupils with siblings in a school to be allocated a place at that school.

Every parent/carer who is applying for a Nursery place for a child must record the current address at which their child is ordinarily resident on the application form.

When processing the application, the local authority will check the child's place of ordinary residence against the records held by the child's school (if applicable). In addition, council tax records for the applicant will be checked.

If an applicant is not registered for council tax at the address of ordinary residence recorded in the application form, the applicant **must** supply documentation **with** the application form that evidences the child's place of ordinary residence. If the local authority is not satisfied by any evidence provided by the applicant and there is ongoing doubt about the child's place of ordinary residence, the local authority reserves the right to undertake further checks and/or seek further verification from the applicant. This will be to assist in the prevention and detection of address fraud for the purpose of gaining an unfair advantage in the school application system.

For the following schools, the governing body of each school is the admission authority and has responsibility for all admission arrangements. If you wish to apply for a Nursery place at one of these schools, you are advised to contact the school directly. The admission criteria for these schools may differ and details are available from the schools and/or their websites.

- St Mary's Catholic Primary School
- St Mary's and St Patrick's Catholic Primary School
- St Robert's Roman Catholic Primary School
- Archdeacon John Lewis Church in Wales Primary School

Parents/carers should note that there is no right of appeal in the case of Nursery admissions.
