## (HENDRE ROAD, PENCOED) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council as the Highway Authority for Pencoed in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) intends in not less than 7 days from the date of this Notice to make an Order which will temporarily introduce the restriction set out in the schedule below.

The Order is necessary in the interests of public safety due to laying a new gas service for 14 meters to the public supply.

The Order will come into force on the 18/04/2025 and will continue in force for a maximum period of 18 months or until such time as the works are completed, whichever is the sooner.

It is anticipated the planned works will be undertaken between 08:30am on the 18/04/2025 and until 16:30pm on the 21/04/2025.

## **Schedule**

No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed on Hendre Road, Pencoed, from its junction with Coed y Graig in an Easterly direction for a distance of 50 meters across the Hendre Road Railway Crossing.

The alternative route for vehicles is via Hendre Road, Min-Y-Nant, Penprysg Road, Penybont Road, Hendre Road and Vice Versa.

Access will be maintained for all emergency services and access to all properties will be maintained at all times during the restrictions.

The restrictions shall however only apply at such time and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
